WHAT TYPE OF SCHOLARSHIP DO YOU OFFER?

The **IMEC Cadet Program** is a scholarship for undertaking a **4.5-year course** in either **Bachelor of Science in Marine Transportation** or **Bachelor of Science in Marine Engineering**. Successful candidates will receive coverage for:

- Tuition fees
- Study at the Maritime Academy of Asia and the Pacific (MAAP) located in Mariveles, Bataan
- Board and lodging within the academy
- Endorsement and employment with our member shipping companies
- STCW Requirements

The program is designed to train future officers and engineers.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN IMEC SCHOLARSHIP EXAM AND MAAP ADMISSIONS TEST?

The IMEC exam is a scholarship examination required for acceptance by IMEC.

The MAAP admission test is a school-regulated exam mandated by CHED.

You need to **take and pass both exams** to become an IMEC cadet.

There is no specific order for taking the exams; simply follow the approved schedule.

The MAAP exam is conducted face-to-face, and they usually visit various provinces to administer the examination.

HOW TO TAKE THE SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION?
